

Registering for Nomad's Recovery Effort on CoinList

In August 2022, Nomad users were impacted by a <u>bridge exploit</u>. Since then, Nomad has recovered a portion of the lost funds, is seeking to return funds to those users in a compliant manner, and has enlisted CoinList to do so. To determine eligibility to access recovered funds with Nomad, you'll need to create a CoinList account, provide basic personal information for our team to complete a standard KYC (Know Your Customer) review, and link your affected Ethereum wallet address. Note that **the wallet address(es) you link MUST be the same address that you bridge assets back from during the recovery process**.

Tips before getting started

You'll need a phone, desktop computer, or a laptop with an enabled webcam Please have your physical ID document available

* Nomad is using the CoinList platform to assist with user compliance checks. **Nomad is not launching a token.**

Step 1 - Begin Registration

If you have not created a CoinList account, you will be prompted to create an account and complete KYC. Please log in with your existing CoinList account if you have previously completed KYC verification on our platform. Once you complete verification, select your verified entity and proceed to the wallet signing step.

Step 2 - Complete KYC/B

KYC (Know Your Customer) and KYB (Know Your Business) verification are required to ensure compliance with regulatory standards. This section will provide information on how to KYC or KYB. Please note that the requirements for KYB within the U.S. differ from non-U.S. entities.

KYC

Required Documents:

- Live Selfie Verification
- Government-issued ID passport, driver's license, or national ID. This document cannot be expired.



 Proof of residence - utility bill, bank statement, or lease agreement dated within the past 3 months.

Some users may be required to provide proof of their source of income. If you do not initially pass KYC, please be on the lookout in your email inbox for follow-up instructions from either accounts@coinlist.co or no-reply@coinlist.co.

KYB

KYB processes differ for U.S. and non-U.S. entities. Please refer to the applicable guide below. We recommend gathering all required documents before completing the onboarding flow to reduce back-and-forth between your team and CoinList's compliance team. We also recommend preparing any directors, signatories, and beneficiaries to be ready to complete KYC.

After uploading the required documents, please be on the lookout in your email inbox for follow-up instructions from either accounts@coinlist.co or no-reply@coinlist.co. Do not respond to the outreach with an email address that differs from what is on the CoinList account.

Step 3 - Link your Wallet

After submitting your KYC information, you will be directed to link your wallet address so that Nomad can determine your eligibility to access recovered funds. If you are not immediately directed back to the Nomad Recovery flow, you can access it here. Please note that only wallets fulfilling the following requirements will be considered:

- Wallet address must be currently holding madAssets in order to bridge back canonical tokens
- Your linked wallet address MUST be both the sending and receiving address when you bridge assets back - you will not be able to send assets to a different destination wallet address (e.g., users with address "0x123...abc" on Evmos can only bridge back to "0x123...abc" on Ethereum)

Note: If you are a DAO or need to verify ownership of a multisig or smart contract wallet, please reach out to us at nomad-recovery@coinlist.co from your CoinList-associated email for next steps, as Wallet Link does not currently support smart contract wallets.
